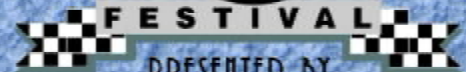

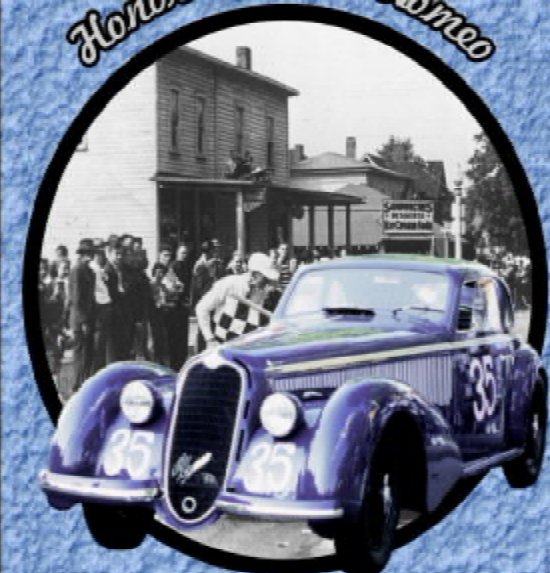

On October 2, 1948, the streets of the sleepy upstate New York village of Watkins Glen came to life with the roar of engines for the first sports car road race in the United States after the Second World War. The 1948 Watkins Glen Grand Prix was just the beginning of great things to come, a beginning championed by the collective vision of Cameron Argetsinger, Don Brubaker, Lester Smalley, and so many other dedicated, hard-working residents of Schuyler County, New York. Since that day in 1948, "the day they stopped the trains," Watkins Glen has emerged as one of the premier road racing communities in the world.

Now, over 50 years later, the community celebrates its rich road racing heritage and the early days of racing in the streets with the annual Grand Prix Festival of Watkins Glen. Experience the excitement and atmosphere of the original street races with this free, all-day festival. There's a lot to do and see!

The Watkins Glen Grand Prix Race Reenactment

Sponsored by Watkins Glen International - the highlight of the festival! See up to 150 of the SVRA race cars from the Zippo U.S. Vintage Grand Prix take two laps of the original 1948-1952 circuit. The reenactment is sure to include some of the cars and drivers from the original Watkins Glen Grand Prix. Your heart will roar along with the engines! Don't miss the Pre-Race Ceremonies at 5:35pm, brought to you by the SVRA and Watkins Glen International.

The Legends Speak - Presented by The International Motor Racing Research Center at Watkins Glen

An interactive panel discussion that gives an insider's view of motorsports history, from the men and women that have "been there and done that." Presented in picturesque Lafayette Park - site of the display parking of this year's featured marque, the Alfa Romeo. This is a "Must Do" for serious racing history fans.

Smalley's Garage Tech Inspection Reenactment

Recreates the traditional Tech Inspection as performed in 1948 - in its original location.

The Kid Racer School and Derby

For children 3 to 6 years of age. A \$10 registration fee includes a 1/2 hour driving school where children are taught the meaning of the colored flags and allowed to take training laps in the Kid Racer battery-powered miniature racing cars. Each child has a chance to compete in The Kid Racer Trophy Dash at 5:30pm - and parents, this is as much fun to watch as it is for the kids to participate in!

Drivers' Walk of Fame Inductions

See this year's selection of legendary Watkins Glen drivers have their Markers in the Walk of Fame dedicated.

Plus... Live music, vendors, and a food court on the historic Schuyler County Courthouse lawn. The Seneca Lake Winery Association will be offering wine tastings - a great chance to sample some of Seneca Lake's finest vintages while you're looking at vintage automobiles.

And Fireworks!

A truly unique show held against the dramatic cliff walls of the Watkins Glen State Park Gorge across from the Court House on Franklin Street. A perfect way to finish a perfect day.
